AVID

AVID stands for *Advancement Via Individual Determination* and is a college preparatory class where students learn how to keep their schoolwork organized and how to take good notes. AVID students also visit college campuses to learn more about the choices available after high school. Twice a week, our students meet with college tutors in small groups to work together answering difficult questions from their classes. All AVID students must take at least one advanced class.

AVID students tend to be from the academic middle, from students in low socio-economic levels, or with extenuating circumstances. However, a parent or teacher may recommend a student who doesn't fit this profile if they feel they would benefit. There are approximately 210 to 220 students enrolled in AVID.

Music Department – Over 50% of the student body is involved in music.

The Choir Department has over 200 students comprising 5 choirs that serve the community. They are involved in local and All State Honor Choirs. Choirs consistently receive “Superior” ratings at festivals.

The Band Department comprises of over 230 students that perform at district and area festivals. Beginning Band, Concert, Symphonic and Jazz Band are offered. The program receives “Excellent to Superior” ratings at festivals on a consistent basis.

The Orchestra Department offers beginning orchestra and a 7th-8th grade orchestra comprising around 100 students. They participate in festivals receiving “Excellent to Superior” ratings. The participation in the orchestra has grown significantly in recent years.

Youth Sports – Around 300 students participate in sports and activities throughout the year. We offer Basketball, Volleyball, Wrestling, Track, Tennis, Dance, Cross Country, Football, and Academic Team (Quiz Bowl).
